What skills are required?

- critical thinking
- problem solving
- ability to troubleshoot
- ability to stand for long periods of time
- ability to communicate well
- ability to lift up to 50 lbs.
- good judgement and decision-making
- attention to detail

What education is required?

- Grade 12 or equivalent
- On-the-job training available

Daily Tasks

- feed raw materials into production machinery
- monitor the production process
- do basic quality and testing checks
- manage inventory
- use lifting equipment and forklift trucks to fill orders
- shipping products
- ensuring clean work areas and equipment



What do they do?

Food industry production labourers help manufacture food products by working on an assembly line, by operating equipment or helping to package and ship those products.

Why is their work important?

Production labourers are key to food manufacturing, ensuring that product handling, packaging and processing meet industry standards.
