

Newsprint Market Price - April 2020 used to determine May 2020 Crown timber dues

Crown timber dues will be set monthly based on the previous month's average commodity prices (\$US) as published in *Pulp and Paper Weekly (RISI)*.

1. To determine the Crown Dues Rate (price/m³) use the "Price \$CDN 45-g (27.7lbs) East \$/tonne" average for the month.

3. In the "Market Price" column find the range which includes the "Price \$CDN 45-g (27.7lbs) East \$/tonne" average for the month.
4. Read across the row to determine the Crown Dues Rate for your location (FMU).

** RISI has discontinued price assessments for Newsprint 48.8g/30 lb newsprint as of April 1, 2019. This change is due to the North American newsprint markets' shift toward lighter basis weights.

RISI will continue assessments of 45g/27.7 lb East newsprint. Manitoba will track the commodity 45g/27.7 lb East newsprint .
