

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

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RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and PIONEER MEAT LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Pioneer Meat Ltd., filed a proposal with the department in connection with the operation of a wastewater lagoon system located in the SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 1, Range 1 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Rhineland, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits, terms and conditions set by a regulation, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to set limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS after giving notice of its intention to set limits, terms and conditions, the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person who was likely to be affected;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the operation on the 15th day of January, 1988;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall operate and maintain the said wastewater lagoon system in such a manner that:
  - (a) there is no discharge of effluent from the said lagoon system without the prior approval of and in accordance with conditions prescribed by the Clean Environment Commission;
  - (b) the release of offensive odours is minimized;
  - (c) the organic loading on the primary cell, as indicated by the five day biochemical oxygen demand, is not in excess of 56 kilograms per hectare per day.

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PIONEER MEAT LTD.

2. The Applicant shall construct the cells of the said wastewater lagoon system with clay or other suitable material such that all interior surfaces of the lagoon are underlain with clay or other suitable material having a hydraulic conductivity of  $1 \times 10^{-7}$  centimetres per second or less.
