THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

TOWN OF ALTONA: APPLICANT

The following limits, terms, and condition shall be complied with in connection with the construction of a temporary sewage dewatering cell and the removal of sewage sludge from a wastewater treatment lagoon located on Lot 1, S.P. Plan No. 2347 M.L.T.O., in the N.E. 1/4 of Section 9-2-1-WPM with final disposal of the sewage sludge at a registered waste disposal ground:

1. The Applicant shall construct and operate the temporary sewage dewatering cell in such a manner as to prevent seepage from affecting adjacent property.
2. The Applicant shall remove all sewage sludge and other solids from the temporary sludge dewatering cell within 30 days and shall place the dewatered sludge in a disposal area within the registered waste disposal ground.
3. The Applicant shall, after depositing the dewatered sewage sludge and other solids in the registered waste disposal ground, place an earthen cover with a minimum thickness of 15 centimetres on top of the sewage sludge and other solids.
4. The Applicant shall, after the sewage sludge and other solids have been removed from the temporary dewatering cell, remove the temporary dikes and restore the dewatering area to its original state.
5. The Applicant shall advise the Director when the project has been completed.
