In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

**THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER
OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION;
"the Licencee"**

for the construction of the Development being the twinning of Provincial Trunk Highway #1 beginning at the south junction of PTH #83 and proceeding in an northwesterly direction for a distance of 8.0 km to a point located to the west of the north junction of PTH #83 in the Rural Municipality of Wallace subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:


SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Manitoba Department of Highways and Transportation Environment Act Proposal, *Proposed Four Laning of Provincial Trunk Highway No. 1 (South Junction of PTH 83 to West of North Junction of PTH 83)*, dated August 17, 1994.
2. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, provide a copy of this Licence to all contractors and sub-contractors involved in the Development.
3. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, consult and reach an agreement with the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Regional Wildlife Branch regarding the location and enhancement opportunities for native prairie and wetland habitat within the Development.
4. The Licencee shall, during construction, adhere to Manitoba Environment's *Temporary Batch Plant Siting Procedures*.
5. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage and fueling areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 meters away from waterbodies and shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.
6. The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit pursuant to the *Manitoba Waste Disposal Ground Regulation, MR 150/91*.
