In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

**THE ARBORG ROD AND GUN CLUB INC. AND THE RURAL  
MUNICIPALITY OF BIFROST: "the Licencee"**

for the construction and operation of the Development being a fishway on a gradient control structure on the Icelandic River in NW 14-23-1E in the Rural Municipality of Bifrost, subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:


**SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. The Licencee shall construct and operate the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated December 21, 1994.
2. The Licencee shall, prior to the commencement of construction, receive the approval of the Director for final plans showing the design of the Development .
3. The Licencee shall ensure that the timber used in the Development is not treated with creosote or penta chlorol phenols.
4. The Licencee shall, prior to the commencement of construction on the Development, obtain an Authorization Permit from Manitoba Natural Resources.
5. The Licencee shall, not less than two weeks in advance of the anticipated date of the commencement of construction of the Development, notify the Riverton office of Manitoba Natural Resources of the anticipated date of commencement of construction, and seek advice from that office respecting methods of controlling illegal activities by members of the public at the Development.
6. The Licencee shall not undertake construction activities on the Development between April 1, 1995 and June 30, 1995.
7. The Licencee shall ensure that appropriate measures are implemented to prevent sedimentation in the Icelandic River during the construction of the Development.
8. The Licencee shall, at the completion of construction, ensure that soil exposed during the construction of the Development is protected with rip rap where high velocity flows could occur, and is revegetated with a mixture of grasses appropriate to riparian areas where high velocity flows would not normally occur.

9. The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction and operation of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with all applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
10. The Licencee shall ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 metres away from all lakes and streams, and shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.

### REVOCATION

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
