AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

Re: The Clean Environment Commission and Mr. L. J. Harpman of Hilversun Kennels, applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Mr. L. J. Harpman, R.R. #2, Dugald, Manitoba has submitted an application to the Clean Environment Commission requesting the Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of a pet boarding kennel located on the SE¼ of 3-12-5E north of Oakbank, Manitoba in the Rural Municipality of Springfield,

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the Clean Environment Commission by any person who is or is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with said operation,

AND WHEREAS the Clean Environment Commission considered the application on the 14th day of May, 1973,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The applicant shall ensure that the total animal population is limited to twenty-five animals on the premises at any one time,
2. The applicant shall ensure that all wastes other than dead-stock are removed in such a manner as to minimize the release of offensive odour and are either conveyed to a municipal refuse waste disposal ground - with the approval of the Municipality - or spread on arable land, owned or under the lawful control of the applicant, in accordance with good agricultural practice,
3. The applicant shall ensure that all dead animals are:
  - (1) removed for final disposal by the owner, or
  - (2) buried with at least two feet of earthen cover in a plot set aside for this purpose on the property of the applicant, or
  - (3) incinerated in an incinerator adequate for this purpose,

: and in any event the method being subject to the approval of the Environmental Protection

- 4) The applicant shall ensure that a high standard of housekeeping and maintenance is carried on commensurate with:
- (1) preventing the occurrence of any unsightly or malodorous situation, and
  - (2) ensuring that there is no deposit, discharge or emission of contaminants off the premises into the environment by reason of the said operation.
