AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

Re: The Clean Environment Commission and The Rural Municipality of Springfield, Village of Dugald, applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Rural Municipality of Springfield, Village of Dugald has submitted an application to the Clean Environment Commission requesting the Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of a sewage lagoon with drainage via the cordite ditch to the Winnipeg Floodway, located in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 3-11-5E in the Rural Municipality of Springfield,

AND WHEREAS a representation was made to the Clean Environment Commission by a person who is or is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation,

AND WHEREAS the Clean Environment Commission held a public hearing on the 29th day of May, 1973 in Building 2, 139 Tuxedo Avenue, Winnipeg,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The applicant shall ensure that all facilities for the treatment of sewage and holding of effluent are constructed of impervious material and said facilities are maintained and operated in such a manner as to prevent the contamination of groundwater,
2. The applicant shall ensure that the said sewage lagoon is operated in such a manner as to minimize the release of offensive odours,
3. The applicant shall ensure that the biochemical oxygen demand loading on the primary cell of the said sewage lagoon does not exceed 50 pounds per acre per day,
4. The applicant shall ensure that:
 - (1) the biochemical oxygen demand of the effluent of the said sewage lagoon does not exceed 30 milligrams per litre,
 - (2) the total coliform MPN index of the effluent of the said sewage lagoon does not exceed 1500 per 100 millilitres of sample,

5. The applicant shall ensure that no discharge of effluent takes place between the first of November in any one year and the fifteenth of May in the following year.
