

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

Re: The Clean Environment Commission and Mr. R. Douglas Shepherd, applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Mr. R. Douglas Shepherd has submitted an application to the Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of a poultry processing operation located on Section 6-12-18W in the Rural Municipality of Elton,

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the Clean Environment Commission by any person who is or is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation,

AND WHEREAS the Clean Environment Commission considered the application on the 28th day of May, 1973,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The applicant shall ensure that all wastes from the said operation are removed and spread on arable land in accordance with good agricultural practice,
2. The applicant shall ensure that all wastes from the said operation be retained on the land under the control of the operator and prevented from entering any body of water, until such time as they are disposed of in accordance with Clause I of this Order,
3. The applicant shall ensure that no commercial evisceration of poultry occurs on the said property,
4. The applicant shall ensure that a high standard of housekeeping is undertaken and maintained at all times, so as to minimize the release of offensive odours.
