

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
 UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

---

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and PLAINS SEEDS LTD., Applicant:

- WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act Plains Seeds Ltd., filed a proposal with the Department of Mines, Natural Resources and Environment in connection with the operation of a seed cleaning plant with associated dust emissions to the atmosphere, the said plant being located in the N.W.¼ of Section 9, Township 25, Range 22 W.P.M. in the Rural Municipality of Gilbert Plains, Manitoba;
- AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under The Clean Environment Act, the said proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;
- AND WHEREAS no representation was made by any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission setting limits on the said operation;
- AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the said proposal on the 20th day of August, 1979;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that particulate emissions from the various processes of the said operation do not exceed 0.23 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury at the point of emission.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that particulate matter from any source of the said operation does not become airborne to such an extent that the particulate matter exhibits an opacity greater than 5 percent past the property line of the said operation.
