RE: Notice of Alteration to Evergreen Environmental Technologies Corporation Licence 2612 RR

Dear Eshetu Beshada,

In 2015 Evergreen Environmental Technologies Corporation approved a partnership with Southwest Regional Development Corporation of Manitoba, and Celtic Power & Machining of Rapid City Manitoba to hold a site demonstration of household waste and other landfill waste material in a gasification process. A request for Alteration to Licence # 2612 RR was received March 29, 2019 and was extended in March of 2021, with an expiry date of March 31, 2022.

Celtic Power & Machining of Rapid City, along with Dillon Consulting ran emissions tests of the Gasifier in August of 2021. Receiving the results of the emissions tests took longer than expected, resulting in delays in the writing and submitting of post-test reports. As you are aware, Conservation and Climate has some questions and/or is seeking some clarification regarding the test results. The delays were unanticipated and though the goal is to complete the project as expeditiously as possible, the timeline for satisfying Climate and Conservation's aforementioned questions and concerns is uncertain.

Evergreen Environmental Technologies Corporation would ask for an extension to the Notice of Alteration to Licence #2612 RR. We ask that it be extended to March 31 2022.
