**Re: Imperial Oil, Environment Act Licence No. 3088**

This is to acknowledge the April 8, 2022 email requesting to discharge approximately 5,000 m<sup>3</sup> of water from the temporary storm water containment pond without confirmation of the results of the acute lethality analysis as stipulated in Environment Act Licence No. 3088.

The request has been reviewed and pursuant to Clause 18(1) of The Environment Act, a suspension to Clause 17 (b) is hereby granted. The suspension of the licence is in effect from April 12, 2022 to April 14, 2022 inclusive, and limited to discharging 5,000 m<sup>3</sup> of storm water. All other clauses of the licence shall remain in effect.

Once the acute lethality results are received, the analytical report must be submitted to the Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Branch for confirmation.
