Dear Director,

We are writing to request an amendment to our environmental license no. 3056. Specifically, we wish to have clause 5 and 6 removed. Instead we will provide relevant information on our website with annual updates.

Our reason for this is due to lack of community participation since inception and over the past year all of our active members have moved away. Of note:

- 5 members representing 4 households, and two Custom Castings employee's comprised the community liaison committee (CLC) in 2014
- 3 people, representing two households and an officer from Manitoba Conservation actively attended our meetings since 2014- 2020
- August 2021 we cancelled the meeting due to lack of participants from the community.
- August September 2021 we advertised in the Herald for community members willing to volunteer for our CLC. One person requested information but was not interested in joining the committee. There is virtually no interest from the community at large.
- November 2021 the meeting was held with no participants from the community, only Manitoba Conservation attended.

It is our belief that by providing a forum via our website will allow our community neighbours to better access our environmental practices and allow us to respond to concerns or questions in a timelier manner.
