

## Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* from the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

### **MANITOBA HYDRO – ST. FRANCOIS-XAVIER NATURAL GAS TRANSMISSION PIPELINE - FILE: 5629.00**

A Proposal has been filed by Manitoba Hydro for the installation of approximately 23 km of new natural gas pipeline from an existing gate station located at Selkirk Avenue (Road 63 North) west of the City of Winnipeg to a new gate station to be located at River Lot 216 in the Rural Municipality of St. François-Xavier and continuing along the Trans-Canada Highway to an existing distribution line located east of the Town of Headingley.
