

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* from the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

MANITOBA INFRASTRUCTURE AND TRANSPORTATION – UPGRADING OF PROVINCIAL TRUNK HIGHWAY 39 - FILE: 5682.00

A Proposal has been filed by Manitoba Infrastructure and Transportation for the proposed upgrading of PTH 39 near Snow Lake, Manitoba to meet current design standards and remove safety hazards. The project involves relocation of an 8.6 km section of PTH 39 from 6 km west of PR 596 to 10 km east of the same PR. Sections of the abandoned portion of PTH 39 will be either used as roadways or decommissioned.
