**Environment Act Proposal (EAP) for the Village of Wawanesa Lagoon**

Dear Ms. Braun:

Attached is a completed Environment Act Proposal Form (EAPF) for the proposed Village of Wawanesa Wastewater Treatment Lagoon in the Rural Municipality of Oakland, Manitoba. The EAPF has been prepared in accordance with the designation of the Project as a Class II development under Regulation 164/88 of Manitoba's Environment Act. It is being submitted by Dillon Consulting Limited (Dillon) on behalf of Manitoba Water Services Board and the Village of Wawanesa as the Proponent. The application fee of \$5,000 is attached, payable to the Minister of Finance.

As previously discussed, Wawanesa's current wastewater treatment plant has ceased to function. Temporary modifications have been made to provide partial treatment until a replacement system can be constructed. We understand that submission of this EAPF will initiate the formal proposal assessment process required by the Environment Act. Due to the urgency of Wawanesa's current need, the Proponent requests expedition of this licence application, where possible. Provided a licence is issued by August 15, 2014, Dillon is of the opinion that construction could be initiated in 2014.
