Hello Jason,

Please find below the additional information request from the Parks and Regional Services Division.

*"I have one statement that I am seeking clarification on. 2a)*

A) *The peat layer removed from the lagoon footprint will be stockpiled on site, adjacent to the lagoon construction area.*

*Will the peat be stockpiled on this site permanently, will it be utilized for other projects or will it be hauled away? The reason I ask this question is that during the construction of the road into the new Water Treatment Plant we were asked if excess peat could be hauled to crown land north of the Dauphin River First Nation. We agreed to this, but required an endorsement letter from the Dauphin River First Nation Chief and Council. The work was completed about 1.5 months ago and we have still not received that letter. I would prefer to deal with things at the front end so if there is any plan to relocate this peat, I would like to see approvals requested and be in place in advance of the project starting. "*
