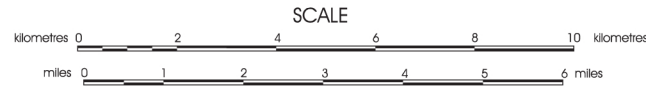


Duck Mountain Provincial Park

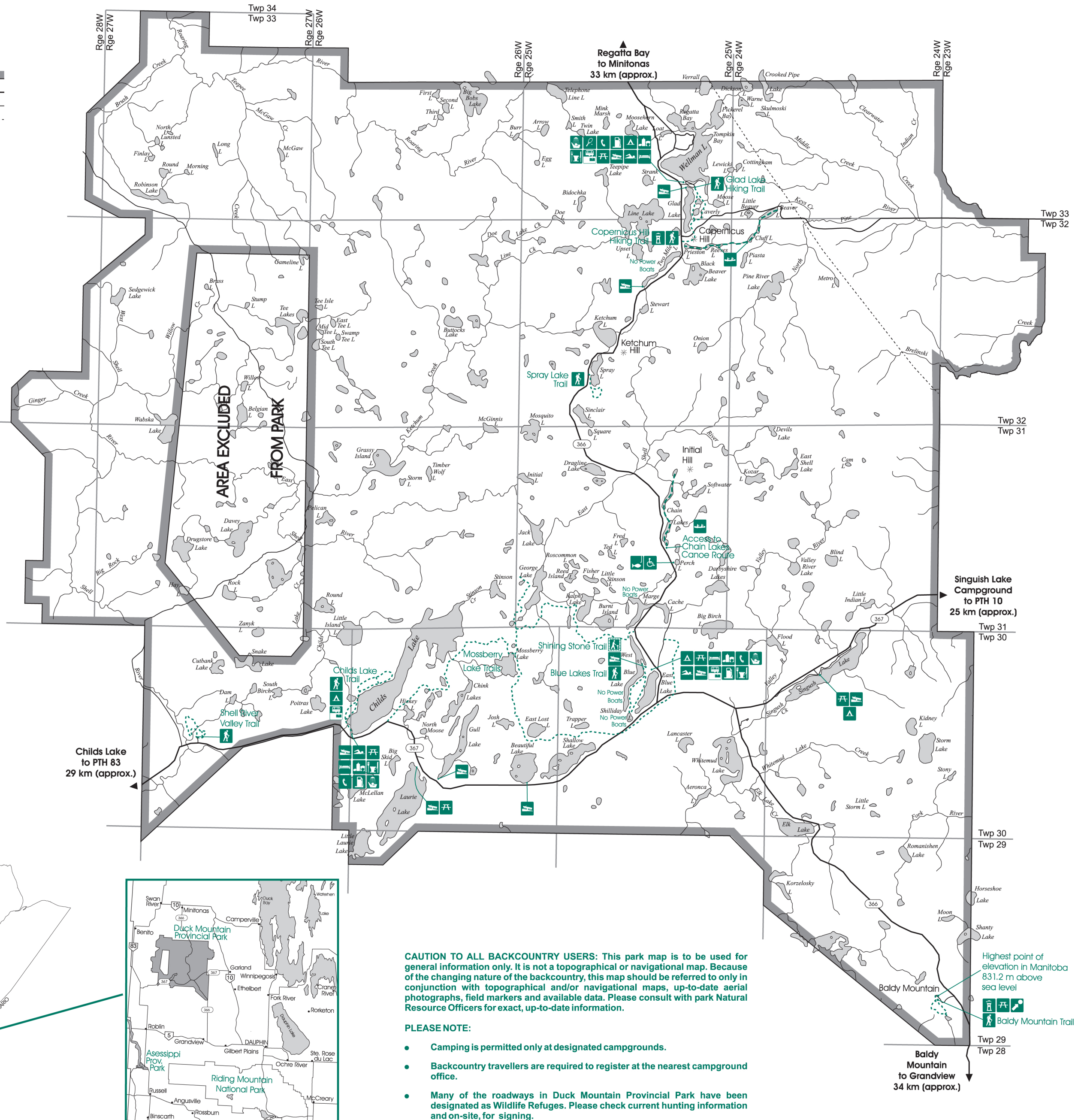
